Whether you honeymoon locally or out of town, don't skimp on the wedding night by spending it at home. Your special day should end with soft Frette linens, plush robes, and ahhh...turndown service. Steal away to a local treasure.

BEVERLY HILLS HOTEL AND BUNGALOWS

There it stands at the top of Rodeo Drive in all its pink majesty: the historic Beverly Hills Hotel. As you cruise up the palmlined drive, you'll feel as though you're entering a bygone era of old-Hollywood elegance. Wander along the property's gardens to the Presidential Bungalow Suite. 

Rick Smith, Jr., co-owner of Sweet Fountains, recommends strawberries, marshmallows, cream puffs, biscotti, pretzels, and most fruits. "Anything that's not crumbly," he suggests. During outdoor receptions, make certain the fountain is shielded from the wind.

Many couples turn to Shelley Beals' melt-in-your-mouth hot doughnut holes. Beals' company, Hot Spot Mini Donuts, supplies a doughnut machine with an attendant, who fries up the morsels on the spot, sprinkling them with powdered sugar, cinnamon sugar, or granulated sugar in vanilla, raspberry, or chocolate flavors. "People especially like to hire us to offer guests doughnuts and coffee at the end of the night while they're waiting for the valet."

If flavors, designs, and alternatives become overwhelming during the wedding plans, Grode offers one last piece of advice: "It's not brain surgery; it's cake. Stay focused on what you're really doing joining your souls together. Your wedding cake should be an articulation of the sweetness of your life and who you are."






